## A hymn study (*Hymnology*) course for elementary schools, Sunday schools, and others.

This program contains 35 of our most beloved songs and hymns. Each hymn includes a captivating history behind its writing and a detailed study of the text. These songs were written by prolific writers such as Luther, Watts, and Crosby, as well as one-time authors. (The great majority of these hymns are found in all Lutheran and general hymnbooks.)

## AGE LEVEL

This course is designed for **middle or upper grade students in Christian elementary schools or Sunday schools**, and it will work well for youth and adult Bible study sessions.

## FORMAT

The program comes with each hymn session in pdf format. The hymn <u>text pages only</u> are also in Word format. This was done because hymn texts may vary slightly in newer hymnbooks. The Word file allows you to make minor text changes however you will lose heading fonts. If you do <u>NOT</u> wish to make text changes, use the pdf file.

You are granted permission to reproduce the pages of each session.

The PowerPoint disk includes an introductory slide to each hymn and the screen text. Schools with PowerPoint software can go into the text slides and easily make text adjustments here, too.

The melody of each hymn is on the disk for listening. All hymns are in *midi* file format. Just click on the file to play. (You may play the song while viewing the PowerPoint slide. Your default music player will play the music. Some music players may be set to loop the song.) **We wish to thank nethymnal.org for their permission in using these melodies.** 

### **OBJECTIVES**

1. **OUR HERITAGE** Our American Christian heritage is rich with songs and hymns that have been treasured by generations of God's people. As each year passes, new hymnbooks are added. Although this can be a good thing, we must be diligent not to lose sight of the songs that shaped our heritage, the songs that were loved by Christians in years past, the songs that were sung around the parlor piano and repeated in Sunday school and church.

- IT'S IMPORTANT How important is it that we become attached to our hymns? In the Psalms we read, "By day the Lord directs his love, at night his song is with me" (Ps. 42:8) and again, "I remembered my songs in the night" (Ps. 77:6). To the psalmists it was very important to have songs become an important part of daily lives so that they could be recalled at any moment to offer strength, comfort, and peace.
- 3. **COMPELLING HISTORY** Many of us have sung these songs again and again, never realizing why they were written or for whom they were intended. Studying the interesting history behind these songs adds another dimension to our enjoyment. What a different picture we get of "Onward Christian Soldiers" when we understand that it was written as a marching song for a children's Sunday school. "It Is Well with My Soul" was written in mid-ocean over the very spot where Horatio Spafford's four daughters drowned just days before. Thus we can appreciate his lyrics, "When sorrows like sea billows roll . . ." Some songs have tragic histories, others triumphant ones.
- 4. **IMPORTANT STUDY** The study section for these hymns deals with terminology, meaning, and scriptural references.
- 5. **ASSIGNMENT** The project is a small assignment which will take the students in many directions regarding our favorite hymns.
- 6. **POWERPOINT** The program comes complete with reproducible pages for the students as well as a PowerPoint disk of slides showing each of the hymns and writers.
