To grow crops

- 4. Genesis 19 – God rained down fire and brimstone (sulphur) on Sodom and Gomorrah
- Joshua 10 – A hailstorm helped Joshua and his army
- Exodus 9 – Moses defeated the Egyptian army at the Red Sea

The great flood

- 5. Numbers 11 – It drove quail into the camp of the Israelites
- Exodus 14 – To dry up the Red Sea so the Israelites could cross
- Jonah 1 – Moved Jonah's ship in another direction
